- Medical care Visit a doctor for routine check-ups, or when you are sick or injured
- Dental care See a dentist for routine cleanings
- Vision care Get an eye exam
- Mental health care and counseling
- Prescription medications
- Reproductive health care, including contraceptives
- Transportation services to medical appointments
- Other medically necessary care, including hospitalizations
