## MISSION:

To provide high-quality medical care and preventive health services to Rhode Island adults who do not have health insurance or cannot afford to purchase those services, and to serve as an educational site for trainees in health care fields. Care is provided by volunteer professionals in partnership with leading hospitals, institutions of higher learning, and community agencies, and includes acute and chronic medical care, preventive services, hospital care, health education, and a pharmacy.

Rhode Island Free Clinic is a fully licensed Outpatient Ambulatory Care Facility with 6 modern exam rooms, ophthalmology unit, podiatry suite, 4 counseling rooms, phlebotomy station, licensed pharmacy, and Wellness Center.

### PHYSICIANS NETWORK

Volunteer doctors and health specialists provide care to qualified patients in their own medical offices throughout Rhode Island.

### WELLNESS WORKS Program

Healthy living classes including yoga, pilates, exercise, and nutrition that promote self-management and prevention of chronic diseases.

### TEACHING PARTNERSHIPS

Brown University Warren Alpert Medical School, University of Rhode Island Colleges of Nursing and Pharmacy, and Medical Assistant Training Programs at Lincoln Technical Institute, Sanford-Brown Institute, Sawyer School, and others.

### PHARMACY

Brand-name pharmaceuticals dispensed for free through the Patient Assistance Program.

### REFERRALS

Free/low-cost diagnostic testing and specialty services at Lifespan, Rhode Island Hospital, Women and Infants Hospital, Rhode Island Medical Imaging, and many other providers.

### VOLUNTEERS

Over 400 doctors, nurse practitioners, nurses, pharmacists, psychologists, physician assistants, interpreters, social workers, medical technicians, and non-medical volunteers provide care.



### BECOME A FREE CLINIC PATIENT

Rhode Island adults interested in Rhode Island Free Clinic care must meet *eligibility requirements* and participate in a monthly *New Patient Lottery*.

### ELIGIBILITY

Rhode Island adults must show:

- ✓ Photo Identification
- ✓ Proof of Rhode Island residence
- ✓ Proof of Income Eligibility.

Qualified patients’ total income can not exceed 150% of Federal Poverty Level. \$16,245 for 1 person, \$38,685 for a family of 5.
