Child Care

Income eligible working families can get help paying for child care for children under the age of 13. The Department of Human Services offers the cost of child care with families who meet the criteria. Families with income above the federal poverty line (FPL) can receive help for a family of 3 or more. Families with income below the FPL can receive help for a family of 1 or more. Child care assistance can be used for care at licensed child care centers, family home child care providers, approved relative or approved providers at the family's home.

SNAP/Food Stamp Program

The Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), formerly called the Food Stamp Program, helps eligible families buy food. Families receive an Electronic Benefits Transfer card (EBT) that is used to pay for food at market checkout counters. The EBT card is similar to a debit/credit card. The amount of benefits families receive is based on household size, income and expenses.

WIC

WIC is a nutrition program for Women, Infants and Children. Program services provide pregnant women and children under age 5 who participate may receive assistance for food and nutrition counseling through the WIC program. Families enrolled in the WIC program are eligible for other services including WIC. For more information, visit www.rikidscount.org.

Cuidado de Menores

El Departamento de Servicios Humanos ofrece el costo del cuidado de niños con familias que cumplen los criterios. Las familias con ingresos por encima de la línea de pobreza federal (LFP) pueden recibir ayuda para un grupo familiar de 3 o más. Las familias con ingresos por debajo de la LFP pueden recibir ayuda para un grupo familiar de 1 o más. El subsidio de cuidado infantil puede utilizarse en centros de cuidado infantil, cuidado en el hogar de una familia de acogida o proveedor de cuidado infantil aprobado. SNAP/Programa de cupones para alimentos

El Programa de Asistencia Alimentaria (SNAP), anteriormente llamado Programa de Alimentos, ayuda a las familias elegibles a comprar alimentos. Las familias reciben una tarjeta de Beneficios de Transferencia Electrónica (EBT) que se utiliza para pagar por los alimentos en los puntos de venta de alimentos. La tarjeta EBT es similar a una tarjeta de débito/credito. La cantidad de beneficios que las familias reciben se basa en el tamaño del grupo familiar, los ingresos y los gastos.

WIC

WIC es un programa nacional de asistencia nutricional para mujeres, bebés e infantes. Los servicios del programa WIC brindan apoyo a las mujeres embarazadas y a los niños menores de 5 años que participan en el programa. Las familias inscritas en el programa WIC también son elegibles para otros servicios, como el cuidado infantil y el cuidado de la salud. Para más información, visite www.rikidscount.org.
