

**Summary of New England Common Assessment Program (NECAP) Level 1 Test Results by Student Group  
October 2009 Test Results, 11th Grade, Rhode Island**

**READING PROFICIENCY**

Overall, 9% (985) of 11th graders scored Substantially Below Proficient in Reading.

Certain groups of students were more likely to score Substantially Below Proficient:

***Race/Ethnicity***

15% of minority students scored Substantially Below Proficient:

18% of Black students scored Substantially Below Proficient.

15% of Latino students scored Substantially Below Proficient.

6% of White students scored Substantially Below Proficient.

***Limited English Proficiency (LEP)***

49% of current Limited English Proficiency students scored Substantially Below Proficient, compared to 8% of all other students.

18% of former LEP students in Monitoring Year 1 scored Substantially Below Proficient.

9% of former LEP students in Monitoring Year 2 scored Substantially Below Proficient.

***Special Education Students with Individualized Education Plans (IEPs)***

35% of students with IEPs scored Substantially Below Proficient, compared to 4% of all other students.

***Economically Disadvantaged Students***

15% of economically disadvantaged students scored Substantially Below Proficient, compared to 6% of all other students.

**MATHEMATICS PROFICIENCY**

Overall, 45% (4,829) of 11th graders scored Substantially Below Proficient in Mathematics.

Certain groups of students were more likely to score Substantially Below Proficient:

***Race/Ethnicity***

67% of minority students scored Substantially Below Proficient.

71% of Black students scored Substantially Below Proficient.

70% of Latino students scored Substantially Below Proficient.

36% of White students scored Substantially Below Proficient.

***Limited English Proficiency (LEP)***

94% of current Limited English Proficiency students scored Substantially Below Proficient, compared to 44% of all other students.

81% of former LEP students in Monitoring Year 1 scored Substantially Below Proficient.

73% of former LEP students in Monitoring Year 2 scored Substantially Below Proficient.

***Special Education Students with Individualized Education Plans (IEPs)***

86% of students with IEPs scored Substantially Below Proficient, compared with 38% of all other students.

***Economically Disadvantaged Students***

65% of economically disadvantaged students scored Substantially Below Proficient, compared to 34% of all other students.
