



UPDATE ON RITE SMILES

RItE Smiles, Rhode Island’s new dental program for children on Medical Assistance, will be enrolling more children into the new dental plan, **UnitedHealthcare Dental-RItE Smiles**. Enrollment in the RItE Smiles dental plan began on September 1. Two additional groups of children will be enrolled on October 1 and November 1. Children living in these towns/cities will be enrolled on the following date as shown below.
