Census Bureau to issue national & state-level data on Tuesday, 9/12: children's health insurance and Thursday, 9/14: poverty & family income

This week, the U.S. Census Bureau will release health insurance, poverty, and family income data from the American Community Survey (ACS) and the Current Population Survey (CPS).

- On **Tuesday, September 12, 2017**, the Census Bureau will release national and state-level **health insurance** estimates.
- On Thursday, September 14, 2017, the Census Bureau will release national and state-level information about poverty and family income.

Rhode Island KIDS COUNT will issue a media release with Rhode Island's trends in these areas.

Please note: The ACS data is the best source of <u>state-level</u> information for Rhode Island. The ACS uses a sample size that is 30 times larger than the CPS, which makes the ACS the most reliable source of information for state-level trends on health insurance, poverty, and family income.
